**Members:** 26 voting and 3 non-voting

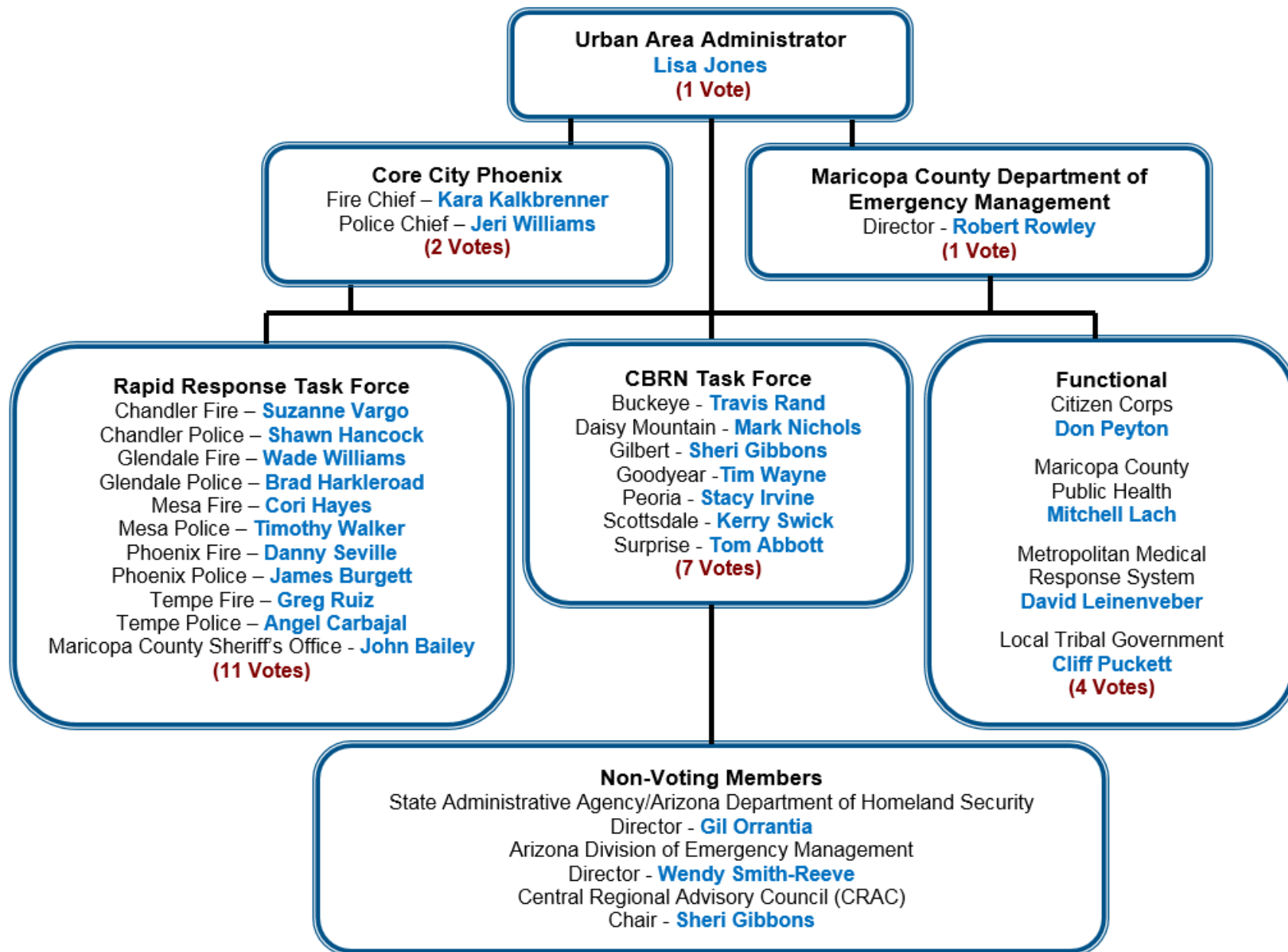
- **Chair** – Lisa Jones

**Responsibilities:**

- Approval body for subcommittees
- Provide recommendations to Executive Committee
- Review and implement goals and objectives in approved Strategic Plan
- Approve grant applications submitted to SAA
- Approve the standards for equipment purchases for jurisdictions using UASI funds
- Recommend funding distribution amounts for UASI grant awards
- Provide oversight to ensure compliance with UASI grant funds.

# Administrative Management – Phoenix UASI

- Subcommittees

- ❑ **Members:** Members of any agency within Phoenix UASI

- Led by two appointed Co-Chairs
    - Co-Chairs of subcommittees shall serve staggered two year terms
    - Executive Committee appoints Co-Chairs for each subcommittee

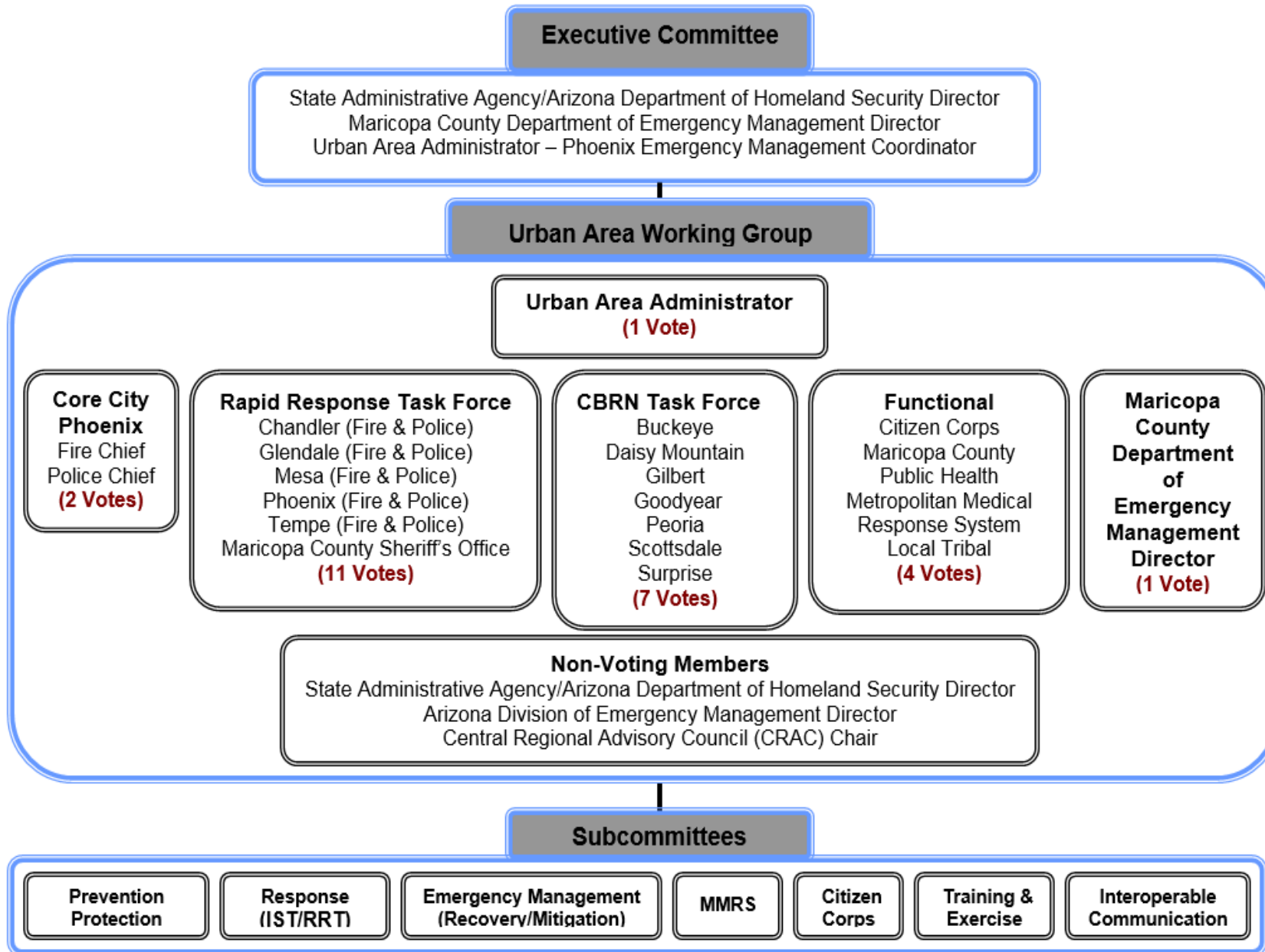
- ❑ **Responsibilities:**

- Carry out initiatives of approved Strategic Plan
    - Develop grant project descriptions
    - Review grant modifications and reallocations for recommendations to UAWG
    - Provide guidance to UAWG – risk reduction measures, core capabilities sustainment and enhancement

# “Presenting Your Project”

- **Due Diligence**

- Does the project have a Terrorism Nexus?
- Does it fit the regional needs and core capabilities?
- Requested funding amount should be based on need

- **Process**

- Project Summary Presentation to subcommittee
- Co-Chairs provide brief presentation on project summaries at UAWG to the voting members
- Jurisdictions submit workbook through AZDOHS portal
- Subcommittees Prioritize Projects
- Subcommittee Co-Chairs make funding recommendations
- Voting Members will vote on the recommendations at UAWG
- AZDOHS Grant Application and Investment Justifications

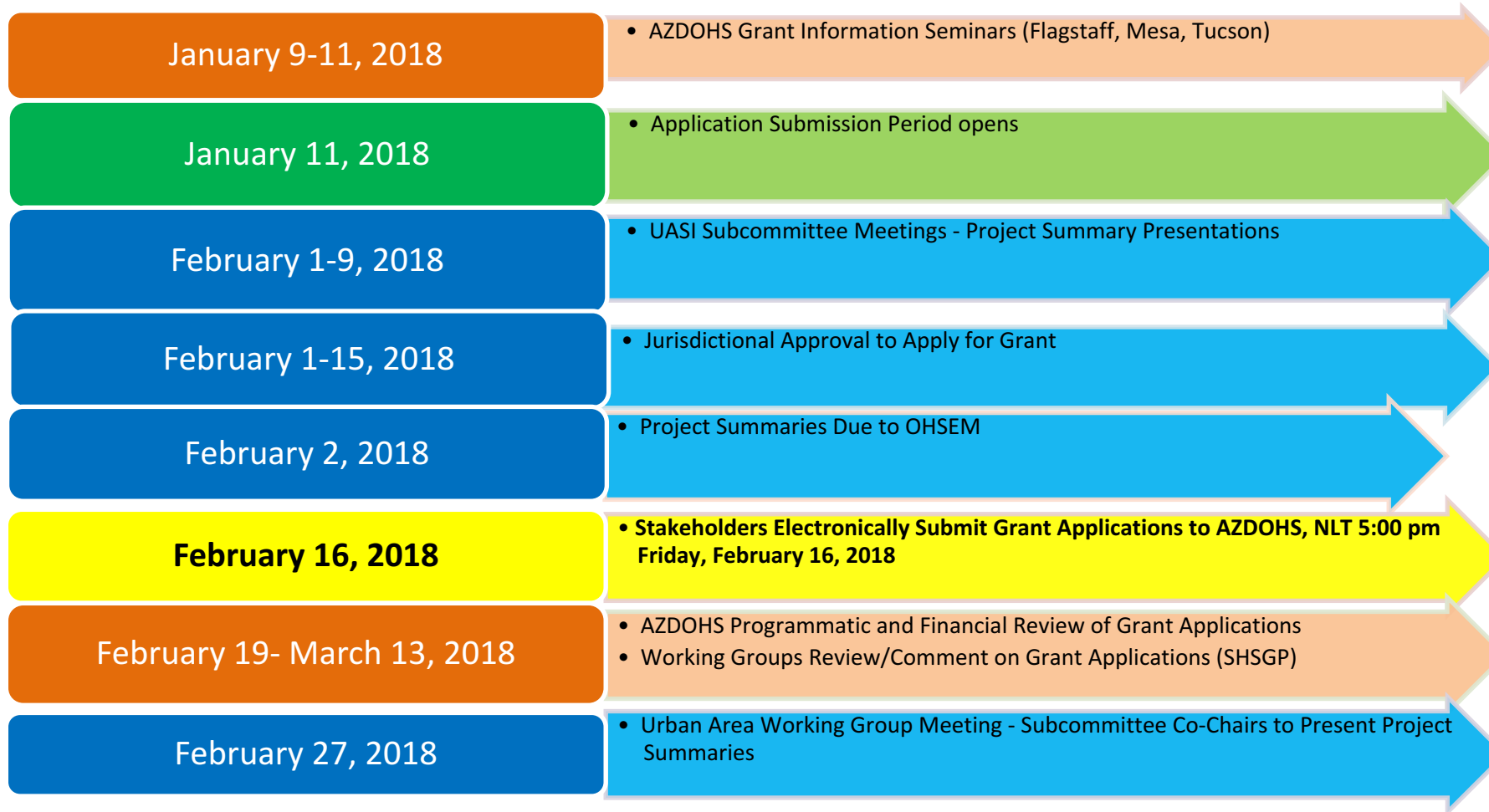
